As the section is currently written, only those members of the board who have been elected are subject to removal for violating association policies and guidelines. Nearly a third of the board is made up of members who are either automatically granted a position on the board by virtue of their position elsewhere at the University or are grandfathered into the structure from having previously served. For the governing documents to apply equitably to all members of the board, these change is needed. This also serves as a way to place appropriate controls on all members of the board, whether elected or otherwise.
